Buffalo Rd/Stony Point Rd **DWI Arrest** **OGD-25-013788**

On 12/5/25, officers were dispatched to a two-car motor vehicle accident. Upon speaking with one of the drivers, officers noted the driver's slurred speech and the odor of an alcoholic beverage. The driver was asked to perform various field sobriety tests and submitted a breath test, which resulted in a BAC of 0.22%. The driver was processed and released with multiple traffic tickets and an appearance ticket.

Slayton Ave **Petit Larceny** **OGD-25-013839**

On 12/6/25, the business reported suspicious activity in the store. The first suspect tried to cash out a cart full of groceries at the self-checkout before abandoning the cart when the EBT card would not work. Meanwhile, the second suspect walked out of the other entrance at the opposite end of the store with a full cart, passing all points of sale. Officers were able to stop the suspects before they left the location. Both suspects were trespassed from the business entirely.

S. Union St **Trespassing** **OGD-25-013906**

On 12/8/25, officers were dispatched to a local bar for reports of a white male refusing to leave the premises after making several inappropriate comments to the staff. The male had an outstanding warrant and was turned over to that agency. He was issued a lifetime ban from the establishment.

Martha St **Disorderly Conduct/Resisting Arrest** **OGD-25-014222**

On 12/15/25, officers responded to reports of a disturbance at a basketball game. Upon arrival, the white female was very irate and screaming in another person's face. Officers advised the suspect to stop using obscene language, or she would be arrested. She failed to comply, was arrested, and released with an appearance ticket.

On 12/21/25, while monitoring traffic, officers observed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed and driving erratically in the area. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle, which turned into a residential driveway. The driver denied operating the vehicle. The homeowner identified themselves shortly thereafter and advised officers that they wished to pursue charges for trespassing. The driver was detained and subsequently arrested for trespassing, issued citations for reckless driving and other traffic violations, and released with an appearance ticket.

On 12/23/25, the victim reported her car had been keyed while she was at the grocery store.
