Lyell Ave **Criminal Mischief** **OGD-26-003783**

On 4/1/26, the caller reported his vehicle had been damaged overnight in the parking lot of his apartment complex.

S. Union St **Petit Larceny** **OGD-26-003893**

On 4/3/26, the business owners reported the sign on their front door had been stolen.

Lyell Ave **Robbery** **OGD-26-003958**

On 4/4/26, the victim reported three unknown males had threatened him with a firearm and demanded the victim hand over his wallet. At one point during the altercation, one of the unknown males smashed the rear window of a nearby vehicle.

Green Spring Ln **Grand Larceny** **OGD-26-004093**

On 4/7/26, the victims reported two suitcases containing various items totaling over \$4600 had been stolen from their driveway.

Hiawatha Trl **Grand Larceny** **OGD-26-004192**

On 4/9/26, the victim reported a check he sent in the mail had been washed and made out to an unknown individual.

On 4/11/26, officers observed a vehicle in the area swerving on the roadway. Officers initiated a traffic stop and made contact with the driver. Officers noted the driver's signs of possible intoxication. When asked to step out of the vehicle, the driver refused several times. The driver also refused field sobriety testing. Officers relayed to the driver that he was under arrest and was brought back to the department where he was processed and issued multiple tickets. He was then transported to the hospital for further evaluation.

S. Union St **DWI Arrest** **OGD-26-004302**

On 4/11/26, officers responded to the area for a report of a single car motor vehicle accident. While speaking with the driver, officers noted a strong odor of alcohol as well as the driver's slurred speech. The driver indicated she had been drinking earlier in the day prompting officers to administer several field sobriety tests. The driver was unable to complete the field tests and the pre-screening breath test. The driver was placed under arrest and brought back to the department. Officers administered a breathalyzer test which indicated a BAC of .18%. Upon completion of the booking process, the driver was released with an appearance ticket for Ogden Town Court.

Beaman Rd/Allandale Dr**DWI Arrest****OGD-26-004554**

On 4/17/26, patrols were dispatched to the area for the report of a person slumped over in a vehicle for at least half an hour. Upon arrival, the male had regained consciousness and was speaking with medical staff. The male was unsure why he had went unconscious and relayed to officers that he was on his way home. Officers observed the male's slurred speech, confusion and bloodshot eyes, prompting field sobriety tests of which the male declined several times. The male was subsequently detained and brought back to the department to be processed. He was released with multiple tickets.
